- 2. **Town Planning.** There were no new planning applications notified in the week. Members considered whether the Forum Steering Committee should make a response to the pre application consultation made by Richborough Estates regarding Ottershaw East. A majority of SC members considered that in the absence of adopted policies against which to reference the initial proposals for the site, representations should not be made, at this time.
- 3. **Master Plan.** An inception meeting with the appointed Local Planning Consultant has been arranged and a full presentation to the Steering Committee Members will be held in early March
- 4. **Finance.** There were no formal Finance matters to report and statements were presented indication planned income and expenditure, in accordance with the approved Budget.

A survey document to seek views of Area Plan Residents and Business is in final draft for distribution in Early March. The Survey is a key stage in enabling the issues and priorities to be addressed in the Plan and Policies, which are representative of those of the Residents.
